

CYBERGROUNDS

Prague-based IDM/dance- and experimental- electronica band combining electronic tracks with live drums, bass guitar, saxophones, tones of synths, and robotic vocals.

Cybergrounds' music can be described as a cheerful soundtrack to a post-apocalyptic movie. The band itself describes it as a "kind of Idiotape playing on Aphex Twin's funeral".

The project started in 2012, when sax player Filip and bass guitarist Ondra decided to explore and exploit whatever electronic instruments could offer to their musical experiments. Over the following months, they put together an eponymous demo EP, combining chilling electronic textures with live instruments. Encouraged by the positive responses, the band began to perform live and released a second single DAZ.

After searching for an appropriate drummer for quite a while, the band finally took on Barney, whose drum kit notably improved the overall sound, and the band finally recorded their first LP "Salt". However, there was still something missing – a vocalist! And as Cybergrounds generally dislike human singers, they created Otylia, the 3D-model animated face robot singer. Otylia is well-mannered, rarely attacks humans, and she can be packed into two suitcases.

In 2023, Cybergrounds released EP "Bound for Hell to save the princess and kill the baddies", produced by Dan Friml.
